

UP NET MEMBER PROFILE

AILEEN GAGNON, WA8DHB KIPLING, MICHIGAN

NOTE: THE FIRST PROFILE OF AILEEN APPEARED IN A 2003 UPN NEWSLETTER. THIS IS A MORE "EXHAUSTIVE" VERSION USING INFORMATION RECENTLY PROVIDED BY AILEEN.

AILEEN RECEIVED HER LICENSE IN OCTORER, 1962. HER HUSBAND, K8ZAS, WAS THE MOTIIVATION AND HE PASSED AWAY LESS THAN A YEAR LATER IN JUNE 1963. SHE AND HER CURRENT HUSBAND, MELVIN, WERE MARRIED IN JULY, 1965 AND, WHILE NOT A HAM HIMSELF, MELVIN IS A STRONG SUPPORTER OF AILEEN'S HAM ACTIVITIES. MELVIN BROUGHT THREE CHILDREN (DAVID, VICKIE, TOREY) AND AILEEN ONE CHILD (PATTI) TO THEIR MARRIAGE AND, TOGETHER, THEY ADDED RICH. AS A RESULT, THEY NOW HAVE NINE GRANDCHILDREN AND NINE GREAT-GRANDCHILDREN. THE GRANDSONS, PARTICULARLY TRAVIS, 14, AND JORDAN, 17, KEEP THEM BUSY ATTENDING BASEBALL, BASKETBALL AND FOOTBALL GAMES PLUS BAND PERFORMANCES.

AILEEN HAS LIVED IN KIPLING ("THAT'S CLOSE TO GLADSTONE AND ESCANABA") SINCE 1953 AND BEEN ACTIVE IN HAM RADIO FOR OVER 40 YEARS. SHE WAS THE UPN MANAGER FROM 1976 TO 1999 AND NOW IS AGAIN SINCE TAKING OVER FROM AA8SN IN JANUARY OF THIS YEAR. SHE HAS SERVED AS ASSISTANT SECTION MANAGER FOR THREE YEARS AND BEEN A NET CONTROL STATION ON THE UP, MACS, MITN AND UPYL NETS. SHE ESTIMATES SHE HAS CONDUCTED ABOUT 3500 UP NET SESSIONS AS NCS TO DATE. AILEEN ALSO CURRENTLY SERVES AS NCS ON THE QCWA SUNDAY NET ONCE A MONTH AND IS A MEMBER OF THE QCWA QUARTER CENTURY CLUB. SHE SERVES FREQUENTLY AS A UPN BACKUP NCS. IN THE PAST, AILEEN HAS BEEN AN ACTIVE TRAFFIC HANDLER AND STILL IS A RELIABLE OUTLET FOR ESCANABA AREA TRAFFIC.

TOGETHER WITH WD81XZ, AILEEN STARTED THE UPN NEWSLETTER IN 1983, EVENTUALLY HANDING IT OFF TO AA8SN WHO PASSED IT TO N8NJA, THE CURRENT EDITOR. SHE HAS ALSO ORGANIZED MANY LOCAL HAMFESTS AND BEEN A STRONG PROMOTER OF HAM RADIO IN THE UP. SHE PUBLISHED THE UP HAM DIRECTORY FOR ABOUT 10 YEARS, STARTED THE HAM OF THE MONTH PROGRAM IN 1977, THE HAM OF THE YEAR PROGRAM IN 1981. SHE HAS SERVED AS HOM CHAIRMAN SINCE JUNE, 2006, TAKING OVER FROM K8BLL WHO SERVED AS CHAIRMAN FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS. AILEEN WAS HOM IN FEBRUARY, 1978 AND HOY IN 1982. HER CURRENT SHACK IS EQUIPPED WITH A SWAN 500C AND YEASU FT 101 WHICH FEED A DIPOLE ANTENNA.

AILEEN IS AN AVID GARDENER AND USED TO HAVE A LARGE VEGETABLE GARDEN AND CANNED MOST OF THE RESULTING VEGGIES. SHE WAS FAMOUS FOR HER BREAD AND BUTTER PICKLES AND PUT UP NUNDREDS OF QUARTS, GIVING MOST TO FRIENDS AND RELATIVES. IN ADDITION TO THE VEGETABLE GARDEN, SHE HAD BOTH RASPBERRY AND STRAWBERRY PATCHES. FOLLOWING REPLACEMENT OF BOTH HIP JOINTS, ONE IN SEPTEMBER, 2003 AND THE OTHER IN APRIL, 2004, SHE NOW IS CONTENT WITH A FLOWER GARDEN.
