

STAN WAS BORN IN NEW ALBANY, INDIANA, IN 1936. HE ATTENDED HIGH SCHOOL IN SUPERIOR, WISCONSIN, OBTAINING A GED WHILE IN THE U.S. NAVY. HE ALSO COMPLETED SOME COLLEGE COURSES WHILE IN THE NAVY. AFTER A SHORT STINT IN 1952 WORKING WITH A GREAT NORTHERN RAILROAD SECTION GANG, STAN JOINED THE U.S. NAVY WHERE HE SERVED FOR THIRTY YEARS, RETIRING IN 1982 AS A GUNNERY MASTER CHIEF PETTY OFFICER. STAN'S DISTINGUISHED NAVY CAREER WILL BE TOLD IN HIS OWN WORDS IN A SERIES OF UPN NEWSLETTER ARTICLES.
